The following are some basic rules when keeping score.

Commandments of Score Keeping

1. Thou shall not talk, text or email while keeping score.
2. Thou shall not move about – STAND STILL
3. Thou shall not look at the shooter, STAND AND FACE THE BOARD
4. Thou shall not call out a score of one dart – UNLESS ASKED
5. Thou shall not tell a shooter what combination to shoot for an out
6. Thou shall not tell the shooter what to shoot
7. Thou shall not change a score if that player has shot again.
8. Thou shall not lean out to see where a dart is or follow darts with body or head movement.
9. Thou shall not show any sign of disgust or excitement while scoring.
11. Thou shall not eat, drink, or smoke/vape while keeping score.
12. Thou shall tell the shooters who won the cork.
13. Thou shall not leave or be relieved as scorekeeper unless he/she is being relieved to throw a match of their own.
