The following are some basic rules when keeping score.

Commandments of Score Keeping

- 1. Thou shall not talk, text or email while keeping score.
 - 2. Thou shall not move about STAND STILL
- 3. Thou shall not look at the shooter, STAND AND FACE THE BOARD
 - 4. Thou shall not call out a score of one dart UNLESS ASKED
- 5. Thou shall not tell a shooter what combination to shoot for an out
 - 6. Thou shall not tell the shooter what to shoot
 - 7. Thou shall not change a score if that player has shot again.
- 8. Thou shall not lean out to see where a dart is or follow darts with body or head movement.
 - 9. Thou shall not show any sign of disgust or excitement while scoring.
 - 11. Thou shall not eat, drink, or smoke/vape while keeping score.
 - 12. Thou shall tell the shooters who won the cork.
 - 13. Thou shall not leave or be relieved as scorekeeper unless he/she is being relieved to throw a match of their own.
